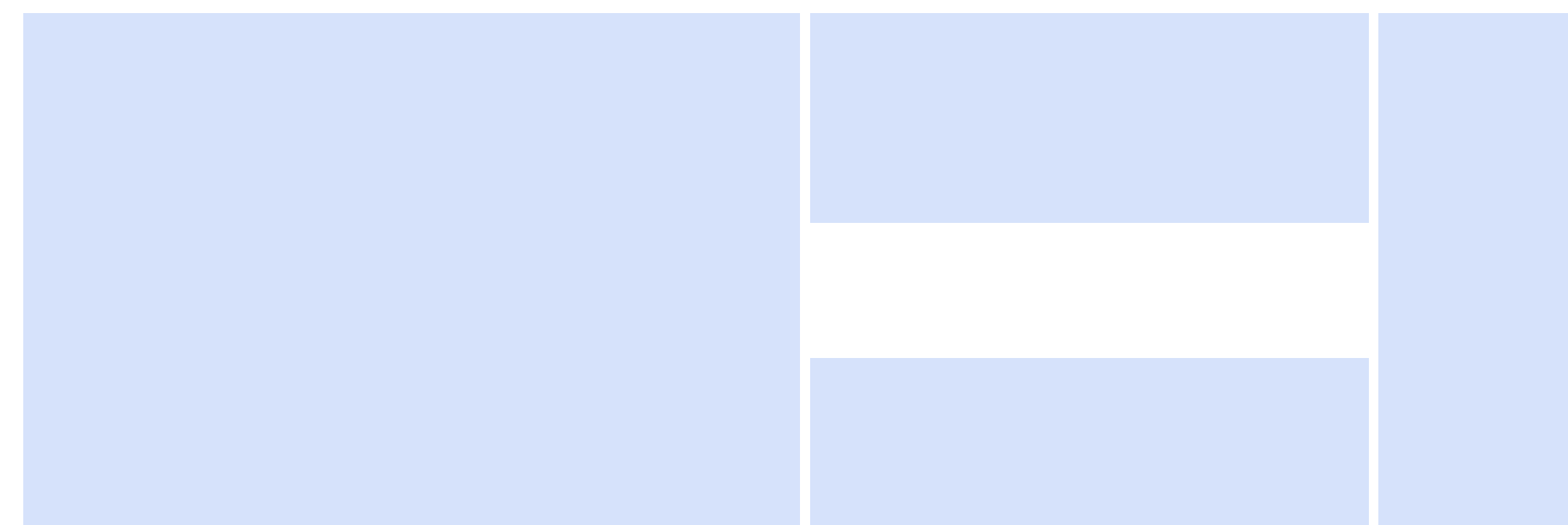
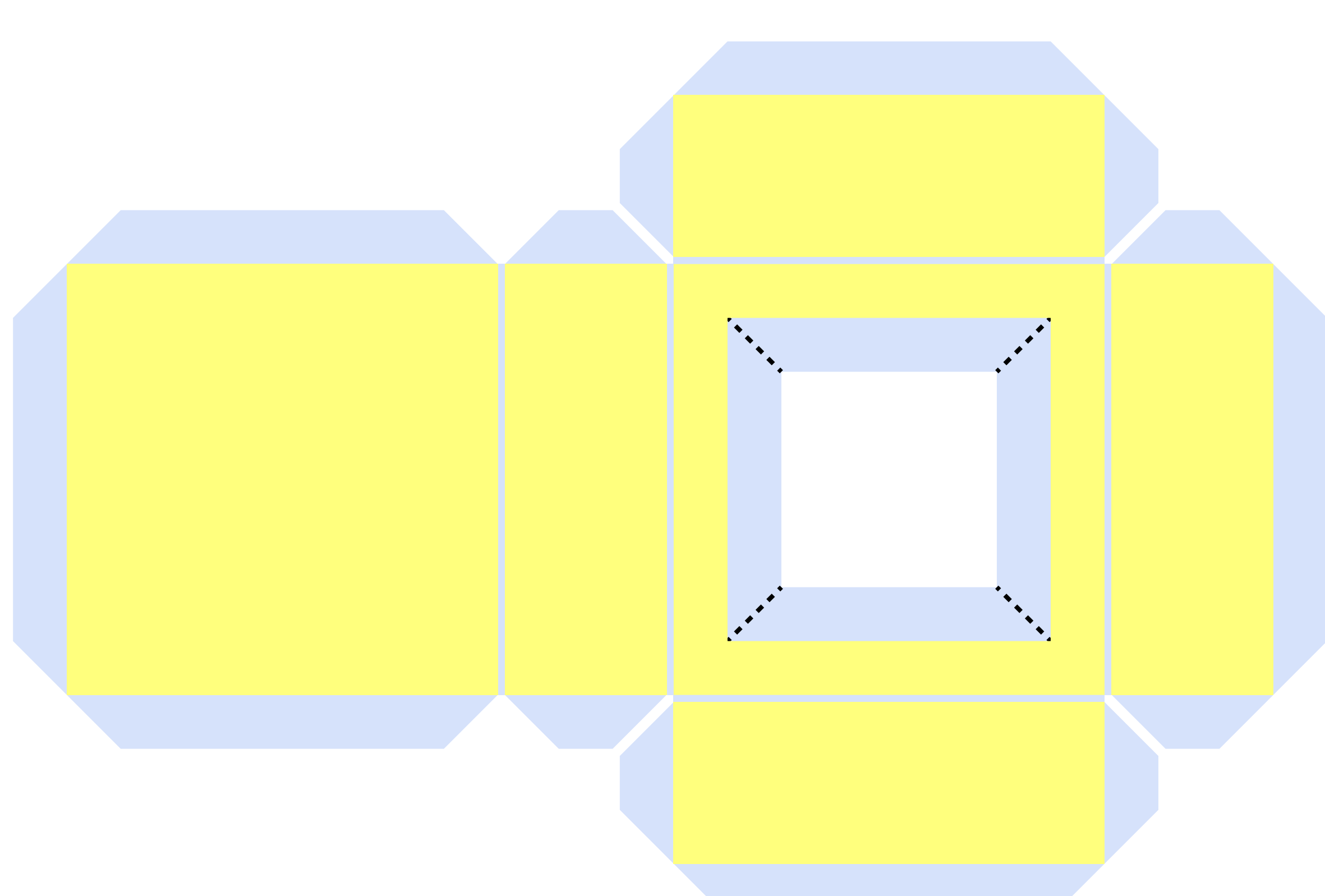
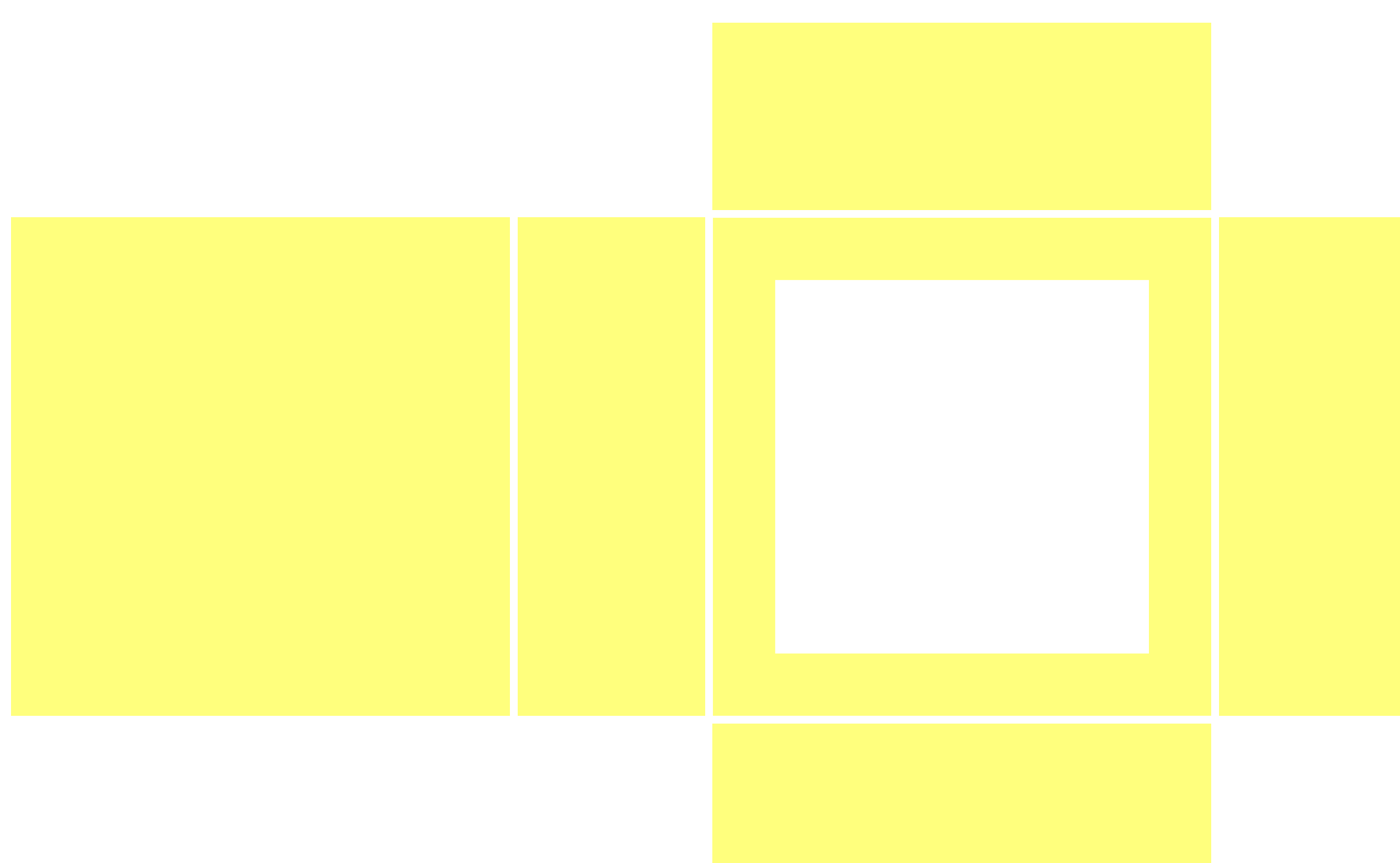


The golden colour depicts the pocket's pattern paper cutting used for keeping warranty card on the top of interior of this layer.
The pastel blue circles are used as a locking system used for this layer along with the magnets embedded in between them and golden motif is used as decorative part for the same.

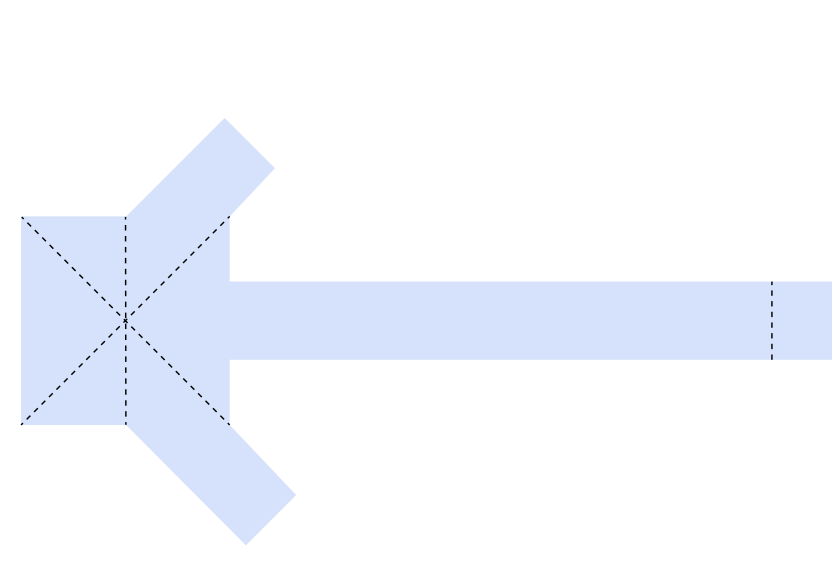
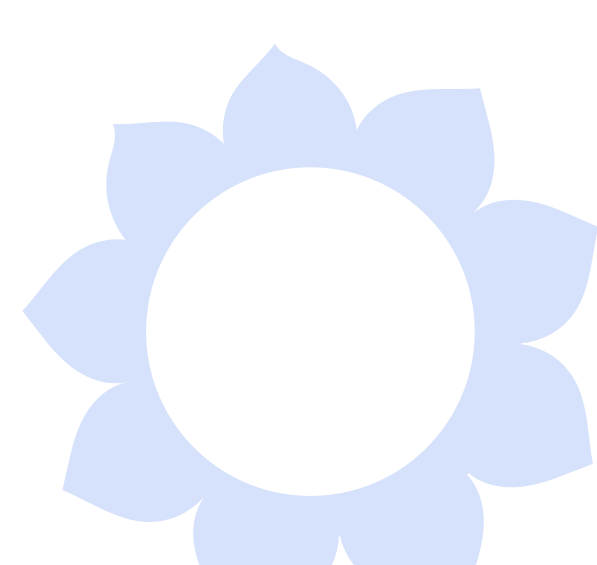
Layer 3
